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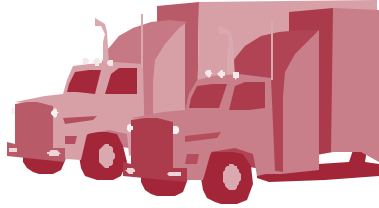

Today there is no such thing as a simple shipment. Carriers describe their fees, services, and terms and conditions in lawyer-prepared manuals. Their fee structures are complex, and vary according to weight, dimension, destination, and over 30 additional variables and surcharges. Palletized LTL (less than truckload) shipments must be adequately wrapped, corner-protected, and banded to minimize damage. Often, inbound shipments must be re-palletized due to product overhang, overheight, uneven stacking, flimsy wrapping, and other problems.
